**WMU Hypertension Study**—Hypertension affects 80 million Americans and can lead to increased risk of coronary heart disease, stroke and contributes to heart and kidney failure. A small reduction in blood pressure can result in a significantly improved outcome. WMU college of Health and Human Services School of Nursing is collaborating with Galilee Baptist Church Praying Hands Health Ministry to conduct a research study on African American women over 60 years of age with high blood pressure. This study will help with learning how to practice self-monitoring and healthy eating to help better manage your blood pressure condition. Volunteers are critical to the success of this study.
